3. He is our Great Saviour
 - a) He is able to save to the uttermost Hebrews 7:25a
 - b) All who come to Him Hebrews 7:25b
 - c) He lives to make intercession Hebrews 7:25c
4. The Person of the Lord Jesus, our great High Priest
 - a) Holy
 - b) Harmless
 - c) undefiled
 - d) Separate from sinners (untainted)
 - e) Higher than the heavens Hebrews 7:26
