

## Noun Charts

### First Declension (α-stem declension - Feminine)

Includes 2 exceptions: Words ending with ης (μαθητης, ου, ό) and ας (νεανιας, ου, ό)

### Second Declension (ο-stem declension - Masculine and Neuter)

### Third Declension (consonant-stem)

ἄγγελος, ου, ό messenger, angel (the context determines the meaning of the word)

Declension is similar to υἱος, ου, ό son

Declension of

**προφητης, ου, ό** prophet

First Declension nouns, ending with ης are masculine

Always note the genitive singular. It will give an important clue as to the gender.

NOMINATIVE	προφητης	προφηται
GENITIVE	προφητου	προφητων
DATIVE	προφητη	προφηταις
ACCUSATIVE	προφητην	προφητας
VOCATIVE	προφητα	(προφηται)

**προσωπον, ου, το** face

2<sup>nd</sup> Declension Neuter Noun

	Singular	Plural
NOMINATIVE	προσωπον	προσωπα
GENITIVE	προσωπου	προσωπων
DATIVE	προσωπω	προσωποις
ACCUSATIVE	προσωπον	προσωπα

## Declension of ὁδός and ἔρημος

Both are 2<sup>nd</sup> Declension nouns but they are feminine in gender.  
These are exceptions. They are declined as masculine nouns

### Declension of ὁδός, οὐ, ἡ path, way

	Singular	Plural
NOMINATIVE	ὁδός	ὁδοί
GENITIVE	ὁδοῦ	ὁδῶν
DATIVE	ὁδῷ	ὁδοίς
ACCUSATIVE	ὁδόν	ὁδούς

### Declension of ἐρημός, οὐ, ἡ wilderness

	Singular	Plural
NOMINATIVE	ἐρημός	ἐρημοί
GENITIVE	ἐρημοῦ	ἐρημῶν
DATIVE	ἐρημῷ	ἐρημοίς
ACCUSATIVE	ἐρημόν	ἐρημούς

### Declension of κύριος, οὐ, ὁ lord

	Singular	Plural
NOMINATIVE	κύριος	κύριοι
GENITIVE	κυρίου	κυρίων
DATIVE	κυρίῳ	κύριοις
ACCUSATIVE	κύριον	κύριους

### Declension of τρίβος, οὐ, ἡ path, pathway

	Singular	Plural
NOMINATIVE	τρίβος	τρίβοι
GENITIVE	τρίβου	τρίβων
DATIVE	τρίβῳ	τρίβοις
ACCUSATIVE	τρίβον	τρίβους
