Title: In Peril of being Unwatchful

(I) THE CALL TO BE WATCHFUL

(Issued by none other than the Lord Jesus Christ)

"Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming." Matthew 24:41

"Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming" Matthew 25:13

"Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." Matthew 26:41

- 1. A very real danger highlighted
- a) The significance of the inferential particle "therefore
- b) It highlights the importance of taking heed to what Jesus said
- c) Dangers include the following:-
- i) People are not naturally watchful
 - ii) People will end up being unwatchful
 - iii) People will succumb to the weakness of the flesh and not pray
- 2. Watching and praying are inseparable
- a) Praying with deep earnestness
- b) Praying for strength to face the trials that lie ahead
- c) Praying for and with those you love
- d) Praying because you are battling against great spiritual forces

Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent.
