- 2. Arising from a soul that has been deeply touched by the Lord

2. Deep personal appreciation

"For He who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is His name" Luke 1:49

"And His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation" Luke 1:50

"He has shown strength with His arm; He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts" **Luke 1:51** 

b) The mighty

"He has put down the mighty from their thrones..." Luke 1:52a

c) The lowly

# "And exalted the lowly" Luke 1:52b

#### 3. The Justice of the Lord

"He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty" **Luke** 1:53

# 4. God's help given to Israel

"He has helped His servant Israel, in remembrance of His mercy, as He spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to His seed forever" **Luke 1:55**

- b) Faithfulness of God
- c) Remembering His promise to Abraham
