"Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles." Isaiah 42:1

- 1. He is introduced as a "Servant"
- 2. He is upheld by the Lord
- 3. He has the anointing of God's Spirit upon Him

### (II) IMPORTANT SIMILARITIES

Between Israel and the Messiah Servant

1. Israel is also called "servant"

"But you, Israel, are My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, The descendants of Abraham, My friend." **Isaiah 41:8** 

### 2. Israel is also upheld by the Lord

"Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am Your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand." **Isaiah 41:10** 

"Listen to Me, O house of Jacob, And all the remnant of the house of Israel, Who have been upheld by Me from birth; Who have been carried from the womb" Isaiah 46:3

#### 3. Israel is promised the outpouring of the Spirit

"For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, And floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring" Isaiah 44:3

### (III) IMPORTANT DIFFERENCES

### Israel the servant versus The Messiah-Servant

#### 1. With reference to character

"He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street." **Isaiah 42:2** 

# 2. With reference to justice

"A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth." **Isaiah 42:3** 

# 3. With reference to His sense of purpose as God's servant

"He will not fail nor be discouraged,
Till He has established justice in the earth;
And the coastlands shall wait for His law." Isaiah 42:4
