(I) A PROBLEM NOT EASILY COMPREHENDED

1. Born blind

"Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth." John 9:1

2. A topic for discussion?

Topic: Who sinned?

- a) The parents?
- b) The blind man?

(II) A PROFOUND ANSWER

1. A straightforward answer

- a) It is not always a question of sin
- b) A deep and profound truth
- "...but that the works of God should be revealed in Him" John 9:3

2. Doing the work of God

"I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work" **John 9:4**

- a) Consciousness of the work of God assigned
- b) Commitment to complete the work of God assigned

(III) THE QUERY OF THE JEWS

1. A Sabbath issue

"Now it was a Sabbath when Jesus made the clay and opened his eyes." John 9:14

2. The rejection of the Jews

- "...This Man is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath..." John 9:16
- "...Give God the glory! We know that this Man is a sinner." John 9:24

3. The incredulous, unbelieving Jews

"But the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind and received his sight..." **John 9:18**

(IV) THE TESTIMONY OF THE MAN BORN BLIND

1. A simple statement of fact

"...A man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed and I received sight.' " **John 9:11**

2. A deeper statement of faith

"...He is a prophet." John 9:17

3. A defence of Jesus

"The man answered and said to them, 'Why, this is a marvellous thing, that you do not know where He is from; yet He has opened my eyes! Now we know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshipper of God and does His will, He hears him... If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing." **John 9:30-31,33**

- a) Mocking of the Jews
- b) Declaration of Faith- That Jesus is from God

4. Suffering for the faith

"…"You were completely born in sins and are you teaching us?' And they cast him out." **John 9:34**

(V) CONFIRMATION OF FAITH

"Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, 'Do you believe in the Son of God?' He answered and said, 'Who is he, Lord, that I may believe in Him?' And Jesus said to him, 'You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you.' Then he said, 'Lord, I believe!' And he worshipped Him." **John 9:35-38**
