(I) A CLASSIC EXAMPLE OF REJOICING IN THE LORD'S WORD

"I rejoice at Your word As one who finds great treasure." **Psalm 119:162**

1. What is "Treasure"?

1. Peace is a treasure

"Great peace have those who love Your law..." Psalm 119:165

- a) God's word gives us peace

2. Hope is a treasure

"LORD, I hope for Your salvation, And I do Your commandments." **Psalm 119:166**

- a) God's word gives us hope
- b) Learn to recall the promises and blessings of the LORD
- c) Learn to rejoice in the hope of the salvation of God

3. Understanding is a treasure

"Let my cry come before You, O LORD; Give me understanding according to Your word." **Psalm 119:169**

- a) God's word gives an "Understanding"
- b) God's word teaches us helps us to walk wisely with a great sense of understanding
