(II) THE GRACE-GIFTS OF GOD

1. Related to the Triumph of Christ

a) Prophetic (Messianic Psalm)

"You have ascended on high,
You have led captivity captive;
You have received gifts among men..." **Psalm 68:18**

b) Fulfillment of this prophecy

"He who descended is also the One who ascended far above the heavens, that He might fill all things." **Ephesians 4:10**

"And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ" **Ephesians 4:11-12**

- a) Apostles (foundations)

- c) Evangelists (on-going)
- d) Pastors Teachers (on-going)

2. The Purpose of these Gifts

- a) To equip the saints
- b) For the work of the ministry
- c) For the edifying of the body of Christ

(IV) OUR RESPONSE TO GOD'S GRACT-GIFTS

"But speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the Head - Christ- from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love." **Ephesians 4:15-16**
