- 1. He had become a disciple (Acts 16:1)
- 2. He was well-spoken of (Acts 16:2)
- 3. He was spotted by Paul and taken under his wings (Acts 16:2)
- 4. He became known as one of Paul's spiritual son (1 Timothy 1:2)

- 1. Acknowledged as "a fellow worker" of Paul (Romans 16:21)
- 2. Described as "a beloved and faithful son" (1 Corinthians 4:17)

- 5. Deep and true sincerity (Philippians 2:20)
- 6. Proven character (Philippians 2:22)
