### (I) A DEADLY AND WICKED DECREE

#### 1. Pharaoh's decree to the Midwives

"If it is a son, then you shall kill him..." **Exodus 1:16** 

### 2. Problem of the Pharaoh

"The people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we..." **Exodus 1:9** 

## (II) DIVINE PROTECTION

# 1. God-fearing midwives

"The midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive." **Exodus 1:17** 

## 2. Strong and healthy mothers

"The Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women; for they are lively and give birth before the midwives come to them." **Exodus 1:19** 

## 3. Loving parents

"And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months" **Exodus** 2:2

### 4. Unexpected royal adoptive mother

"The daughter of the Pharaoh...saw the child... had compassion on him" **Exodus 2:5-6** 

### (III) DIVINE PLAN

- 1. Moses was saved from certain death when he was but an infant
- 2. He was especially protected from any harm or danger as he grew up-being of the royal Egyptian household
  - a) He would otherwise have been a slave
  - b) He could have died while serving under cruel bondage
- 3. God's Divine plan was for him to become the deliverer of Israel from the tyranny of Egypt
- 4. That Divine plan existed even before Moses understood it
