(II) A CHILD SPECIALLY DEDICATED TO GOD

1. Decision made for Samuel to serve the Lord forever

"Then I will take him, that he may appear before the Lord and remain there forever." **1 Samuel** 1:22

2. Personally raising him up till he was weaned

"Then the woman stayed and nursed her son until she had weaned him." 1 Samuel 1:21

3. Lent to the Lord for the rest of his life.

"As long as he lives he shall be lent to the Lord." 1 Samuel 1:28

(III) A CHILD TO BE ESTABLISHED AS A SERVANT OF GOD

"Do what seems best to you; wait until you weaned him. Only let the Lord establish His word." **1 Samuel 1:23**
