(III) THE FRUITS OF WILLIAM CAREY'S LABOUR

1. Initial Converts

- a) Krishnu, the first convert
- b) 6 more of low caste were baptised

2. Translation work

- a) The whole Bible in 30 different languages
- b) Becoming a professor of Bengali at Fort William College
 - i) Taught the British officials the Bengali language in the morning
 - ii) Preach the gospel to the poor and needy at night

3. Growth of work

- a) Serampore missions work in 1817
 - i) 10 mission stations in Bengal, supported by nine missionaries.
 - ii) 765 baptisms, 500 were Indians.
- b) More missionaries came and work extended before Serampore
- c) Brought about the cesation of the Suttee Widow burning
