1. Not a believer

- a) Drinking

2. Becoming a believer

- a) Invited by a friend to a Bible study
- b) Experience the reality of God

3. Becoming a servant of God

- a) Accepted as a missionary by the London Society
- b) The Lord brought him to Bristol
- c) Started a preaching ministry at the Churches

(II) GEORGE MULLER - HAVING A VIBRANT FAITH AND LIFE

1. Faith in the word of God

- a) A man guided by the word of God from beginning of his ministry to the end
- b) Read the Bible through 200 times
- c) Started the Scripture knowledge Institution for home and abroad
 - i) 63 years of ministry

ii) Distributed more than 200,000 Bibles all over the word
