(I) DEFINING THE WILL OF GOD

"Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother" Colossians 1:1

1. Meaning of the word "will" (thelema)

- a) Simply, it is what one wishes or desires
- b) It has to do with one's desire or will to do something

2. Man's will

- a) Superficial
- b) Most uncertain

(II) AN EXAMPLE OF APPLYING THE WILL OF GOD

"Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother" Colossians 1:1

How do we see the will of God being applied in Paul's life?

1. Paul's life was determined by the will of God

- a) By... "dia"...by means of, instrumental
- b) "Means" would indicate that Paul's life was pre-determined by the will of God

2. The will of God was decreed as His calling for Paul

a) He was specially chosen and called by God

"But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel." **Acts 9:16**

b) It was God's will for Him

"Then he said, 'The God of our fathers has chosen you that you should know His will," **Acts** 22:14

3. The will of God was confirmed in the life of Paul

- a) The direction for his life
- b) The destiny of his life
