(III) THINGS THAT CAN THWART OUR ATTEMPTS TO SING

"How long, O LORD? Will You forget me forever? How long would You hide Your face from me?

How long shall I take counsel in my soul, Having sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me?" **Psalm 13:1-2**

- 1. When God seems to have forgotten us
- 2. When God seems to have hidden His face from us
- 3. When sorrow seems to fill the heart daily
- 4. When the troubles of life (enemies) seem to have the upper hand.

- 1. We can and must pray (Psalm 13:3a)
- 2. We must pray for enlightenment (Psalm 12:3b)
