1. Praying to God for His help

a) Faith to ask for help

i) To deliver (Psalm 59:1)

ii) To defend (Psalm 59:1)

b) Invoking Powerful names of God

i) "O Lord God of hosts" Psalm 59:5

ii) "The God of Israel..." Psalm 59:5

2. Praying with Knowledge of God's power

3. Patience to wait on the Lord and His power

- a) Waiting on God as our strength and our defense (Psalm 59:9-10)
- b) Waiting on the mercy of God (Psalm 59:9)

4. Personal experience of God's power

- a) Experience God being there as defense and refuge (**Psalm 59:16**)
- b) Truth Always seeing God as our defense (Psalm 59:17)
