- 3. Did any people ever hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of fire...? (Deuteronomy 4:33)
  - a) The marvellous manifestation of God at Mount Sinai (Exodus 19-20)
  - b) The giving of the 10 commandments
- 4. Did God ever try to go and take for Himself a nation from the midst of another nation by trials, by signs, by wonders, by war, and by a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and great terrors...? (Deuteronomy 4:34)
  - a) God's mighty sings in Egypt
  - b) God's deliverance of Israel from bondage to Egypt
