- 1. With reference to the mighty**
 - a) God can make a mighty city a ruin (**Isaiah 25:2**)
 - b) He can make a palace of foreigners to be a city no more (**Isaiah 25:2b**)
- 2. With reference to the poor and needy**
 - a) He can give them strength (**Isaiah 25:4a**)
 - b) He can provide for them in their distress (**Isaiah 25:4b**)
 - i) A refuge from the storm
 - ii) A shade from the heat

(III) A GREAT PROPHETIC GLIMPSE OF THE FUTURE

- 1. Alien enemies will be soundly defeated (Isaiah 25:5)**
- 2. God will provide wonderfully for His victorious people (Isaiah 25:6)**
- 3. He will destroy death forever (Isaiah 25:8)**
- 4. He will wipe away all tears (Isaiah 25:8b)**
